This is Geraldine. She has graduated from University with a degree in Applied Social Science.




This is Martha. She has graduated from University with a degree in Sociology.

'The finance that I got I used to put down a deposit and to pay the rent'






'We didn't have a guarantor... they've made us pay four months of rent up front which was over £3000'






'I'm using the money that I have – my savings and the money from the graduation bursary - so that's been very useful that I have that to pay for driving lessons'
